Directions for Certification:

1. The Parish Catechetical Leader or the Adult Faith Formation Coordinator is responsible for keeping this form updated for each Catechist. Corresponding Records of Attendance, Certificates of Completion, and this Reporting Form remain on file in the parish. **In addition, each catechist should keep her or his own copy of all these documents.**
2. The PCL/AFFC supervises and signs the Reporting Form for Initial and Intermediate Certification and then requests certificates from the Office for Faith Formation/Catechetics.
3. When the catechist formation process is completed, the Reporting Form, all Records of Attendance, and Certificates of Completion are submitted to an EMCF for evaluation. After the EMCF has signed the Reporting Form, the PCL/AFFC sends only this form (keeping a copy) to the Office for Faith Formation/Catechetics for Advanced Certification.
